Covered Facilities: Southwest Healthcare Services and Southwest Health District Unit - Bowman, ND

<u>Community Health Needs Assessment</u>: A Community Health Needs Assessment (CHNA) was performed in Winter 2016 in collaboration with public health to determine the most pressing health needs of the Bowman, ND area.

<u>Implementation Plan Goals</u>: The Board of Southwest Healthcare Services has determined that the following health needs identified in the CHNA should be addressed through the implementation strategy noted for each need:

1) Ability to recruit and retain primary care providers

- > Specific Needs Identified in CHNA:
 - Workforce recruitment and retention is a major challenge facing the community. (page 38; ranking number 1)
- Current activities
 - Conducted by hospital
 - Advertise jobs in print, social media and online
 - Work with the UND Center for Rural Health for recruitment efforts
 - Review all 3RNet Candidate referrals
 - Work with Inline Group for Physician Recruitment

Proposed activities

- Conducted in collaboration with others
 - Work with West River Health Services on recruitment efforts
 - Work with Sanford Health on recruitment efforts
 - Work with UND School of Medicine to begin resident program at SWHS
 - Engage other physician recruitment firms as necessary.
- Create a recruitment/ retention committee

Measurable Outcomes

- Hire 1-2 Physicians for Southwest Healthcare Services
- Hire an Advanced Practice Provider for Southwest Healthcare Services

2) Mental/Behavior Health and Drug/Alcohol Use and Abuse

- Specific Needs Identified in CHNA:
 - Lack of addiction and mental health services are a major challenge facing the community (page 36; ranking number 1)
 - Would like SWHS to add mental health services. (Mental Health on page 40)
- Current activities
 - Conducted by hospital
 - Working with the Center for Psychiatric Care to provide Mental Health services to the Bowman community.
 - ♦ They will provide mental health through telemedicine
 - ♦ This program will begin in the summer of 2017

Proposed activities

- Conducted in collaboration with others
 - SWHS will work with Bowman County Health Nurse and Social Services to promote this new service to people who have a need for or who may be interested in these services.
- This new service will be marketed to the community via newspaper, website, radio and social media.
- Provide education on drug/alcohol use and abuse

Measurable Outcomes

By providing mental health service by the summer of 2017.

3) Attracting and Retaining Young Families

- Specific Needs Identified in CHNA:
 - Cannot grow businesses if people are retiring--need to bring in the young families (page 35; ranking number 1).
- Current activities
 - Conducted by hospital
 - Recruitment of Staff
 - Human Resources main goal is recruitment of staff--which includes young families.
 - Conducted by Bowman County EDC
 - Reviews different areas for economic growth which will attract young families
 - Support local businesses to provide quality of life for our community
 - Continues to work with different businesses in the recruitment of staff

Proposed activities

- Conducted in collaboration with others
 - SWHS will work (when asked) with Bowman County EDC, Bowman County School and any other business that is working on staff recruitment.
