<u>Tickets and Tables:</u> Tickets are \$50 each. Tables may consist of as little as 6 people and as many as 40. Each table will get one free ticket for a celebrity, regardless of how many waiters you have. You are welcome to have as many waiters as needed to service your table. Should you decide to have a table, please contact Alli Engelhart, Debbie Patterson, or Allison Pretzer to receive a packet! Please fill out the ticket stubs completely; we use this for our auction numbers and need phone numbers and addresses for accounting purposes. Please remember that the ticket stub correlates with the bidder number so it would be best to write the name of the person on the bidder number as well. <u>Please fill out the bottom portion of this paper and return with your ticket stubs and left over tickets as well as payment in full to Cole Benz (office 523-2862), Debbie Patterson (cell 523-6482), or Lindsey Schaaf (office 523-2847) by February 15th.</u>

<u>Set Up:</u> Set up will be 2-8 p.m. on Friday, March 1 and again 9 a.m. – 2 p.m. on Sat, March 2. Table configurations will be set up when you arrive to decorate your table. *Due to the time and effort that it takes to fit all of our guests in the 4 Seasons, please try to relay any special requests to the Celebrity Waiter committee by the deadline for ticket return when you return the bottom portion of this paper.* Due to the fantastic turnout that we have, we ask that your decorations take up no more room than the tables themselves. Also, please take in to consideration the height of your decorations to not block the view of the people behind you or plan accordingly when you turn in your special requests. We want to keep this event enjoyable for all and allow everyone to see during the live auction. All tables/decorations are required to be cleared off at the end of the night. No live animals or hay is permitted per 4 Seasons regulations.
