

To protect the health and safety of our community, Southwest Healthcare Services has been limiting the number of visitors to the hospital in recent weeks, while implementing enhanced screening efforts of all visitors.

After careful consideration of the welfare of our patients, their families, and our staff and the threat of the rising spread of COVID-19, Southwest Healthcare Services has updated its visitor restriction policy effective April 9, 2020:

• One visitor per patient per day, immediate family only. NO visitors under the age of 16

• Family members will be screened about recent travel and signs of illness, including a temperature check.

-Any persons with symptoms will not be permitted to visit.

-Any persons with recent travel from a locatoin deemed by the North Dakota Department of Health to require quarantine will not be permitted to visit.

• The hospital reserves the right to restrcit all visitor in the event a patient requires strict isolation measures.
